Individual Student Comments:

In response to the question: What aspects of the course were most useful for your learning?

- I liked how organized the class was. For example, a to-do list was made each day to show what needed to be completed and by when. That was really helpful for me in managing my time not only in the short term but for the coming weeks.
- All of the days before a quiz she would do practice problems with us so that we could have a refresher. Something that was also helpful was how well she explained problems and if you didn't understand it she would help you a different way until you got it.
- I think Elise did a great job when teaching this course. She was always very helpful and on top of things.
- Learning with classmates and my instructor was excellent.
- Her office hours whenever I needed help finishing up a assignment she was able to always help me and help me understand it better.
- Going over problems as a class as well as individual work time.
- The fact that my instructor was very easy to reach out to. Helped me learn and retain the material a lot better than I thought I could.

In response to the question: When this class is taught again, what changes would you suggest?

- The only change I would suggest would be regarding ALEKS. With being quite time consuming, I felt the ALEKS modules were taking time away from studying for upcoming quizzes/exams.
- I wouldn't change anything, I love how this class was run and how helpful our teacher was.

- Not much she was a ideal teacher and seems to be very prepared.
- I would suggest required attendance, and having our quizzes at the end of the week, instead of the beginning of the next, since some people may not retain information well over the weekend. - For the future of this course, I would like to see a couple of days reviewing for the exam. We still had one designated class day for reviewing but it was usually the day before the exam. I would like to have at least 2 days of designated review class time for exams.
